Itinerary and Hotels

DAY 1: Arrive Christchurch (D)

DAY 8: Queenstown - Milford Sound Overnight Cruise (B,D)

DAY 9: Milford Sound - Te Anau - Invercargill (B,D)

Begin your day with a hearty breakfast before heading back out to the Tasman Sea (weather permitting) to explore more of the fiord. Return to the wharf to meet your coach and enjoy the scenic drive to Te Anau for a short break. Continue your journey to Invercargill, where you visit Bill Richardsons Transport World for a guided tour of this remarkable private collection, housed in a purpose-built Art Deco building. The displays feature vintage trucks, rare classic cars, petrol pumps and an ever-growing showcase of Wearable Arts.

DAY 10: Invercargill - The Catlins - Dunedin (B,L,D)

A visit to Curioscape located on picturesque Curio Bay will provide an interactive experience on the region followed by lunch. DAY 11: Dunedin (B)

Farewell Dunedin and travel to Oamaru famous for its limestone. Follow the Waitaki River as you marvel at Mt Cook, New Zealand's highest peak. DAY 13: Twizel - Christchurch (B,SD)
